Eco-Friendly Features of Frontier Airlines' Terminal at SFO



<u>San Francisco Airport Frontier Terminal</u> has several green characteristics in line with the airport's policy. SFO has been a pioneer of several environmental campaigns, such as faring well on a carbon neutrality index and installing efficient recycling and composting systems for the whole terminal. There are also recycling bins scattered within the airport to facilitate waste management. Also contributing to the terminal's lessened environmental impact, the design incorporates features such as energy-saving lighting and plumbing appliances.

Furthermore, in as much as waste management is concerned, SFO intends to make clean energy use. The Airport has solar panels built in which are used for supplying power to some of the airport's facilities including the terminal of Frontier Airlines. SFO strives for a 'zero net energy' strategy where the amount of energy consumed within the terminal is the same as what is generated from the airport for the benefit of the passengers. In addition, further facilitating the use of green transport to and from the airport is the provision of Electric Vehicle (EV) charging points in the respective parking spaces.

In addition, SFO enhances the airport's philosophies on sustainable dining and shopping by encouraging their restaurants and shops to be equipped with environmentally friendly

materials. Most of these restaurants have organic foods and locally grown food for customers. In addition, stores also use reusable bags instead of plastic ones and sell ecofriendly products. These measures lessen the environmental concerns of the airport, resulting in more sustainable travel for passengers taking Frontier Airlines.
